

A GUIDE TO COP 30



UNITED NATIONS CLIMATE CHANGE CONFERENCE

COP stands for **Conference of the Parties**, which is basically a large-scale, high-level meeting of the countries that have ratified the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). Why the number 30? Because this will be the 30th session of the Conference of the Parties.

WHEN COP30 will take place from the 10 to 21 November 2025.

WHERE Belém do Pará, Brasil.

WHO It is estimated that around 60,000 people will participate in COP30. This figure includes delegates from approximately 190 countries, as well as representatives from institutions, non-governmental organizations, private sectors and other interested stakeholders.

OUR 4 CALLS

01 Cancel the debts of poor countries
as unjust and unpayable debts should not compromise resources for climate adaptation and mitigation efforts.

02 Strengthen the Loss and Damage Fund (FRLD)
by allocating sufficient resources to tackle the severe effects of climate change.

03 Set clear targets for a fair energy transition that aims to reduce CO2 emissions
considering historical responsibilities, respecting human rights—especially Indigenous rights, valuing and protecting nature, and prioritizing sustainable livelihoods over profit-driven models

04 Set clear goals to develop a global food system based on food sovereignty and agroecological practices
one that promotes culturally adapted methods for production, transformation, distribution, and food consumption.
